| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These are companies with whom you share your stand. • Co-exhibitors do not necessarily have a legal relationship to your company. • They are companies with whom you share your stand and as a result they have access to all services associated with registration. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These are companies whose products you represent on your stand and which must be declared to the Organiser. • It is compulsory that represented companies have a legal or commercial relationship with your company (parent company, subsidiary, principal, distributor, etc.). |

What does registration include?

It covers **the same entitlements as that of a direct exhibitor**:

- Administration of application
- Presentation of equipment, products, services and technology on the stand
- Inclusion in the official exhibition catalogue, with full contact details, in the lists of exhibitors and on the website
- 1 catalogue
- Use of promotional media
- 10 exhibitor badges
- 1 pigeonhole in the press office
- Access to the VIP Lounge and press office
- **NEW AT INTERMAT** free unlimited number of invitations (subject to availability, batches of 100)

It covers:

- Presentation of equipment, products, technology and services on the applicant's stand
- Inclusion of company name in the official exhibition catalogue, in the lists of exhibitors and on the website.

Procedure and registration fees

- Every co-exhibiting company must **submit a fully completed registration application** indicating the name of the exhibiting company with which it is sharing a stand, **and giving the stand area as 0 sq.m.**
- It must pay a registration fee of €855 excl. VAT and standard insurance of €117 excl. VAT*

**subject to premium increases imposed by the insurance company*

Only companies that have returned a fully completed and signed **DECLARATION OF REPRESENTATION** form and whose registration fee of €225 excl. VAT has been paid by the applicant will benefit from the services detailed above.

Companies that have not completed these formalities may be excluded from presenting their products and services at the exhibition.

Trade fairs and specialist exhibitions are subject to the provisions of French law no. 2006-85 of 27 January 2006 and the decree of 12 June 2006, and therefore French or international importers or agents must accompany their registration application with a declaration from their principal certifying that they are authorised to represent them on the stand they are applying for. The compulsory fee is €225 excl. VAT for each represented company. Only represented companies that can produce a Declaration of Representation and whose registration fee has been **paid by the exhibitor** may appear in the official lists and in the exhibition catalogue. **The Organiser reserves the right to exclude from the exhibition companies, brands and equipment for which no corresponding Declaration of Representation has been returned and/or registration fee paid.**

You have the right to access and amend information concerning you: to do so, please contact the exhibition organiser.
